Important Reminders!!

COMPLETED parade entries are lined up by category in the order that they are received. Entry forms must be filled out completely, including length of unit for staging purposes!! **YOU WILL NOT BE ADDED TO THE LINEUP IF THE ENTRY FORM IS NOT COMPLETE.** **Measure carefully!! Our parade has outgrown the current line-up area making correct measurements of your parade entries very important.** Please measure accurately, if the length estimate needs to be revised after your original submission of your entry, please contact parade director, Stephanie at 641-481-6291.

Safety concerns have increased dramatically over the past couple of years due to children rushing into the street to pick up candy. The Oktoberfest parade permits candy distribution, **HOWEVER it must be given out by people walking alongside the entry. Throwing candy from floats or vehicles is not permitted.**

Horses in the parade must be bagged, or be accompanied by a scooper in order to be considerate of other parade entries. **Horses must also stay off of private lawns.** We reserve the right to dismiss riders/horses that do not follow these rules.
